

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I bring my own food and drinks on the golf course?

No. However, there are concessions available at each club house as well as beverage carts that circle the courses often.

2. How old does my child have to be to golf alone?

10 years of age,

3. What is the course rating of Brighton and Sheridan?

Brighton:

Blue Tee= 71.2/119

White Tee= 69.8/118

Red Tee= 71.4/113

Gold Tee= 66.3/115

Sheridan:

Blue Tee= 71.5/124

White Tee= 70.2/121

Red Tee= 71.0/119

4. Can I just go play golf without a tee time?

Yes this is possible, however to guarantee a tee time call 879-6688 or go online to TTYPR.com.

5. Can I bring a caddy to the golf course?

No.

6. Can I have a friend ride or walk with me on the course but not play?

No.

7. Do you rent clubs?

No we do not rent clubs. Each player must bring his/her own set.

8. Is there a practice area at each golf course?

There are practice putting greens at each golf course and there is also a driving range across from Brighton golf course. Fees for the driving range can be found on the outdoor driving range webpage.

9. How late in the evening can I rent a cart to go out and play?

Anytime, as long as the cart is returned by dusk.

10. What is the dress code?

Proper golf attire is required. No tank tops are to be worn and shirts must be worn at all times.

11. How old does a golfer have to be in order to rent a golf cart?

The golfer must have a valid driver's license in order to rent a cart.

12. Do the golf courses have a Pro Shop?

You can purchase balls, gloves, and tees at both locations.

13. What is the rain check policy?

Players can obtain a rain check up to 90 minutes after they tee off.

14. Are there lessons available?
