



Special Notice for Sauna & Steam Room Users

Given the hundreds of people that use the sauna, steam room each week, rarely do our sauna and steam room not operate as they should.

Each unit has its own heat generating unit---the heating elements in the sauna's heater and a steam boiler for the steam room.

Each unit "cycles" in its own way to generate heat (sauna) and steam (steam room) and time is required to do so. We cannot rush that time.

Spitting, squirting, and pouring water on the units will only,:

- a) require each unit to overheat
- b) lead to failure (resulting in extensive down time and repair)
- c) overextend the heating cycle (leading to a fire, in the case of the sauna)

Each unit cycles until a temperature is reached then turns off (i.e. the sauna) or needs time to recover to create steam and pressure (i.e. the steam room). Once the minimum temperature or pressure is reached, it begins to heat up or deliver steam.

Regardless, any of these conditions will shorten the life of these units to the point that they need to be repaired or replaced.

Anyone caught tampering with, or placing cold water soaked paper towels or cloths, spitting, squirting or pouring water on, the sensors in either of these rooms, will have their membership terminated without refund.
