RE: Snow Plowed on Sidewalks & Location of Permit Sticker

All Commercial Snow Plow Operators issued Snow Plowing Permits through the Town of Tonawanda Town Clerk are reminded of the following statutory prohibitions toward depositing snow on the sidewalk:

New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, Section 1219, prohibits the depositing of snow upon any highway. Section 118 of the Vehicle & Traffic Law defines the "Highway" as "the entire width between boundary lines of every way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel". This definition then includes the sidewalk as part of the highway, and makes the depositing of snow on the sidewalk a violation of Section 1219.

The code of The Town of Tonawanda, Section 183-6, prohibits any person, firm, or corporation from depositing any snow, slush, or ice on any street or other public place in the Town of Tonawanda, outside the Village of Kenmore. Section 183-2 of the code of The Town of Tonawanda includes the sidewalk as part of the street.

The permit must be permanently affixed to the driver's side window or the rear window of the vehicle, and must be visible at all times when the vehicle is engaged in plowing in the Town of Tonawanda.

This communication serves as a notice to all commercial snow plow operators issued snow plowing permits through the office of the Tonawanda Town Clerk that any violations of the above cited statutes may result in arrest of the violator as well as revocation of the permit by the Town Clerk.
