Beginning Wednesday, February 1st, 2017 between 8 am - 4 pm, the Town of Tonawanda Youth, Parks & Recreation Department will be accepting applications for the 2017 T-Ball program from residents of the Town of Tonawanda or Village of Kenmore. The registration will be at the Youth, Parks & Recreation Department Office, 299 Decatur Road, & the Aquatic & Fitness Center.

This 9-week program will be held on Saturdays at Lincoln Park Beginning Saturday, June 3rd through August 5th with an end of season pizza party immediately following on the 5th. The times will be on a rotating basis from either 10:15 am - 11:30 am or 12:15 am - 1:30 pm.

The goals of the t-ball program are to teach the basic skills and knowledge of baseball such as fielding skills, throwing, hitting, base running and sportsmanship.

The cost of the program will be:

Residents: \$70.00 (w/o candy) or \$100.00 (with candy)

Non Residents: \$105.00 (w/o candy) or \$135.00 (with candy)

This fee includes: Individual Instruction, League Games, T-Shirt Jersey, Hat, and Pizza Party in recognition of all participants.

Players will be given 60 candy bars to sell or eat, if they choose to accept candy. After candy bar sales, the 9-week program will cost \$40.00 per resident player and \$75.00 per non-resident player.
