**** ATTENTION RESIDENTS ****

Recently, the Town of Tonawanda made changes to its Sanitation Ordinance with regards to Recycling Collection. You will now be required to place all of your recyclable material into a Town-issued recycling tote. Please take a moment to review the changes:

The new tote recycling program will start on **September 18th** and will follow a **bi-weekly** schedule for collection after that. Please refer to the enclosed recycling calendar to determine which week your pick-up will begin. The color of the paper this letter is printed on indicates the color you are to follow on the calendar. For example, if your letter is yellow, your bi-weekly collection will begin the week of September 25th on your garbage day. If your letter is blue, your bi-weekly collection will begin the week of September 18th on your garbage day. The new schedule has been **specifically determined for your street** and may not encompass your entire neighborhood.

Each residence will be issued a 65-gallon black tote with a green lid. Simply place all of your recyclable material into your tote and wheel it to the curb on your scheduled day. You will not need to bag or separate your recyclable material in any way.

- a. **Your pick-up for all garbage and non-recyclables will remain the same. Your garbage collection day has not changed and will still be picked up on a weekly basis.**
- b. All recyclable materials must be placed in your new recycling tote. However, if there are items that cannot fit properly inside, please set them next to the tote.
- c. After September 18th, the orange recycling bins will no longer be collected at curbside. However, these bins are recyclable. If you would like to dispose of your bin, either place it inside your new recycling tote or next to the tote **EMPTY** to indicate it is to be recycled.

RECYCLING RULES

1. All recycling must fit in the tote with the lid closed in order for it to be collected.
2. Items such as plastic lawn furniture may be placed next to your recycling tote for collection.
3. Your tote(s) may be placed at the curb no more than 24 hours in advance of collection and must be at the curb by 7:00 am on collection day. Removal of the emptied tote must be done within 24 hours as well.
4. We will continue to monitor the contents of the containers as they are dumped into the trucks. If trash and non-recyclable material is placed into the recycling tote, it will not be collected.

RODENT CONTROL MEASURES



Improper Garbage Storage

Occupant to dispose of garbage. Every occupant of a dwelling or dwelling unit shall dispose of and store all his garbage or any other organic waste which might provide food for insects or rodents, in a clean, sanitary safe manner. Garbage and non recyclable waste material, refuse and rubbish shall be placed in a Town provided tote.

Bird Feeding

No person shall feed in the open any domestic or wild fowl, birds, or animals other than in a suitable container and in such a manner so as to prevent scattering of food upon the ground or ground level which can or will provide food for rodents, insects, vermin or other pests.

Rodent Harborage

Every occupant of a dwelling or dwelling unit shall store and dispose of accumulated rubbish, boxes, lumber, scrap metal, or any other materials in such a manner as to prevent rodent harborage in or about any dwelling or dwelling unit. Materials shall be stacked neatly in piles elevated to a level high enough to permit effective cleaning.

Dog Waste and Fruit Fallen From Trees

Every owner or occupant of a dwelling or dwelling unit shall not store, place, or allow to accumulate any materials that may serve as food or harborage for rodents in a site accessible to rodents.

MATERIALS		WHAT NOT TO DO
NEWSPAPER & MAGAZINES 	Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, post cards, stationery, tablet paper, white & colored paper, computer paper, business forms, envelopes, folders, coupons, paper bags and phone books.	DO NOT INCLUDE: Paper that has been soiled by food or drink, books, napkins, tissue paper, paper towels, wax paper, carbon paper, wrapping paper, blueprint or photographic paper and foam egg containers.
CARDBOARD 	Corrugated cardboard & boxboard including shoe boxes, gift boxes, dry food boxes, and cereal boxes (without bags). All cardboard must fit inside tote.	DO NOT INCLUDE: Soiled cardboard, coated with wax or any other material, any with packing attached, pizza boxes, refrigerated food packaging and any soft drink or beer carton packaging ("wet board"), styrofoam.
MILK & JUICE CARTONS 	Milk Cartons, Juice Cartons, Drink Boxes Gable Top Beverage Containers including those with plastic spouts.	DO NOT INCLUDE: Straws from drink boxes, frozen food containers, waxed paper or foil drink pouches, caps from beverage container spouts.
GLASS BOTTLES & JARS 	All clear, green, and brown food & beverage bottles & jars. All must be clean of contents	DO NOT INCLUDE: Ceramic beer & wine caps, ceramic cups & plates, flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, mirror & window glass, drinking glasses, heat resistant ovenware, eye glasses or hypodermic syringes.
METAL CANS 	All metal food & beverage cans. EMPTY aerosol cans. EMPTY paint cans. Metal lids, closures, caps & metal cookware All must be clean of contents	DO NOT INCLUDE: Propane cylinders, silverware, batteries, metal/cardboard containers (frozen juice, oil) small appliances, tin foil, scrap metal or hypodermic syringes.
PLASTIC CONTAINERS 	Plastic food, soap, & beverage small mouth bottles and large #1-7 plastic	DO NOT INCLUDE: Do not include motor oil or anti-freeze. No take-out or deli packaging

INFORMATION ON OTHER WASTE (None of the following items should be placed in recycling tote)

TIRES: Tires must be brought to the Highway Department at 450 Woodward Avenue and will be disposed of for a small fee. Tires on rims will be an additional \$1.00/tire. Any OTR 1125 series or larger will be accepted. **TIRES WILL NOT BE COLLECTED AT YOUR CURB.**

WASTE OIL, ANTI-FREEZE, PAINT & AUTOMOTIVE BATTERIES:

Put all used motor oil and anti-freeze in a SEALED container separate from the rest of your garbage/trash, and place it at your curb on your regular collection day. Label containers as to contents. **DO NOT MIX OIL AND ANTI-FREEZE.** Empty oil and anti-freeze containers should be included with your regular garbage. Place automotive batteries at your curb on your regular collection day.

PAINT should be placed at your curb in its original container, separate from all other garbage/trash. **EMPTY** paint cans can be placed with recyclables if they are clean.

WE WILL NOT ACCEPT gas, gas and oil mix, or any other flammable material, chlorine, also any fungicide, pesticide, acid or any other toxic material.

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING:

Electronic items (computers, monitors, printers, televisions, etc.) may be placed at the curb on regular collection day for pick up by our Electronics Recycling truck. However televisions or computer monitors containing CRT (Cathode Ray Tube) are not accepted. For a list of proper disposal sites please contact www.erie.gov/recycling.

LARGE APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:

Put appliances and scrap metal at your curb on your regular collection day. Remove all doors from refrigerators and freezers. Metal strips and/or poles must be no longer than 6 feet and tied in bundles no heavier than 60 pounds.

BRUSH, TREE PARTS, LEAVES, AND SNOW REMOVAL:

Tree branches, shrubs, wood and lumber must be cut and tied into bundles with heavy twine or rope. Bundles cannot exceed 60 pounds in weight and six feet (6') in length. Keep metal separate from wood. Small Christmas trees may be placed at the curb without stands, plastic bags, or ornaments. **Do not plow, blow or shovel leaves or snow into the street. Sidewalks must be kept clear of snow and other debris.**

BROKEN GLASS AND HYPODERMIC NEEDLES:

BROKEN GLASS and other sharp items such as **HYPODERMIC NEEDLES** must be carefully wrapped and placed securely inside a hard plastic container or box, such as a cereal carton, before being placed for collection with your garbage. Large quantities can be placed in a closed container and marked as to contents so your collection crew can take necessary precautions. These items must be included with your regular garbage as specified or they will not be collected. Do not put these items in your recycling bin.

CONTRACTOR DEBRIS:

Any and all debris resulting from work done by a contractor must be removed by the contractor that did the work. **THE TOWN WILL NOT COLLECT ANY CONTRACTOR DEBRIS.**

****TOTE MUST BE KEPT CLEAN**, CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS CAN BE USED AT CURBSIDE FOR YARD WASTE. ANY MATERIAL PLACED IN GARBAGE CANS (PLASTIC OR STEEL) WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.**

DO NOT PUT ANY GARBAGE/TRASH AT YOUR CURB MORE THAN 24 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED COLLECTION

ALL EMPTY TOTES MUST BE REMOVED FROM YOUR CURB BY THE END OF YOUR COLLECTION DAY
