TOWN OF TONAWANDA DECLARES STATE OF EMERGENCY

TOWN OF TONAWANDA, NY— Town of Tonawanda Supervisor Joseph Emminger, declared a State of Emergency for the Town effective at 3:00 PM on Sunday, March 15. The State of Emergency will stay in effect for 5-days and will be revisited at that time. The State of Emergency is in response to three confirmed COVID19 cases in Erie County and County Executive Mark Poloncarz’s State of Emergency for Erie County declared earlier in the day.

As part of the State of Emergency, all Town facilities will be closed to the public effective at the end of business on March 15. The only departments that will remain open to the public will be the Town Clerk office, the Building Department and the Town Court. The Town of Tonawanda Senior Center will be open for congregate meals on Monday only and will be closed after that date.

All town employees are to report to work on Monday, March 16, 2020.
