Public Review Period

The Town of Tonawanda must file an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice, 5-Year Consolidated Plan (2020-2024), and Annual Action Plan with the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in order to receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) program funds. The Towns of Amherst, Cheektowaga and Tonawanda have formed a Consortium for the purpose of applying for federal HOME Investment Partnership funds. The Town of Amherst (as lead community for the Consortium) will file the Town of Tonawanda's HOME Investment Partnership program in their Annual Action Plan.

The Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice documents obstacles to fair housing choice within the region and within the Town of Tonawanda and creates a set of action plans to mitigate the identified obstacles. The 5-Year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan lists projects proposed for funding by the Town of Tonawanda for CDBG, ESG and HOME funds. Draft plans are available for public review and comment from December 13, 2019 through January 15, 2020, at the following locations: Town of Tonawanda Planning & Development Office, 169 Sheridan Parkside Drive, Tonawanda; Town Clerk's Office, 2919 Delaware Avenue, Kenmore; Village Clerk's Office, 2919 Delaware Avenue, Kenmore; Kenilworth Library, 318 Montrose Avenue, Tonawanda; Kenmore Library, 160 Delaware Road, Kenmore; and on the web at www.tonawanda.ny.us (go to the DEPARTMENT tab and scroll down to Planning & Development).
