Public Review Period

The Town of Tonawanda must file an Annual Action Plan with the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in order to receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) program funds. The Towns of Amherst, Cheektowaga and Tonawanda have formed a Consortium for the purpose of applying for federal HOME Investment Partnership funds. The Town of Amherst (as lead community for the Consortium) will file the Town of Tonawanda's HOME Investment Partnership program in their Annual Action Plan.

The Annual Action Plan lists projects proposed for funding by the Town of Tonawanda for CDBG, ESG and HOME funds. The draft plan is available for public review and comment from December 9, 2020 through January 15, 2021, at the following locations: Town of Tonawanda Planning & Development Office, 169 Sheridan Parkside Drive, Tonawanda (by appointment only); Town Clerk's Office, 2919 Delaware Avenue, Kenmore; Village Clerk's Office, 2919 Delaware Avenue, Kenmore; Kenilworth Library, 318 Montrose Avenue, Tonawanda; and Kenmore Library, 160 Delaware Road, Kenmore. Should any or all of these locations be shut down due to COVID related restrictions, the draft plan is also available on the web at www.tonawanda.ny.us (go to the DEPARTMENT tab and scroll down to Planning & Development).
