



COVID-19 Spray Park Policies

Wellness:

- All children & spectators entering the spray park must be registered. Parents must fill out a registration card with their child's first & last name, address cell phone number (s) and email address when registering their child for so that the staff can easily correspond with them if necessary. There are no exceptions to this. Participants & spectators will not be allowed in unless registered.
- Once the spray park has opened, attendants & children/parents should monitor their health daily.
- Spray Park staff will be told to report any COVID-19 symptoms to their supervisors. If any staff member reports any respiratory illness symptoms, they will be told to stay home. If any staff member reports symptoms during the work day, they will be sent home immediately.
- If your child is displaying any symptoms of COVID-19 or you think they may have been exposed, please notify us immediately at 831-1001.
- If an attendant, spray park participant or spectator is confirmed to have COVID-19, staff & families will be informed of their potential exposure, while maintaining confidentiality.
- If the spray park staff notices your child exhibiting symptoms, you will be notified to pick them up immediately and they will not be able to return until cleared. The health & safety of all participants & staff is of the upmost importance.

Day to Day Operations:

- Participants will go in one gate & out the other. **No exceptions! Staff will be monitoring both locations & they will be clearly marked.**
- 50 participants will be allowed into the concrete area of the spray park at a time. Spectators will be required to fit within an outlined designated area on the grass. The maximum time limit for the grassy areas will be 1 hour to allow for other families to use them. Vulnerable populations should stay home.
- Temperatures of all staff will be taken daily with a touchless thermometer.
- As participants & spectators arrive each day, their temperature will be taken with a touchless thermometer & the staff will perform a wellness check by asking various questions. This information will be kept in a health screening assessment log.
- If participants answer "yes" to any screening questions or have a fever of 100.4 or higher, they will be sent home & their parents/guardian will be notified. They will not be allowed back to the spray park until they are cleared to do so and a letter from their doctor must be forwarded to the Youth, Parks & Recreation Department.
- Participants will maintain enforceable physical distancing.
- Hand sanitizer will be available & must be used at check-in, when leaving leaving & as often as possible while using the spray park.
- Any personal belongings that participants bring will be staggered 6 feet apart from any others or with their parents/guardians in the spectator area.
- Staff will frequently sanitize the equipment & bathrooms by spraying or wiping them down with hospital grade disinfectant.
- Attendants will wear masks and masks will be optional for participants & spectators.
