Beginning February 3, 2020 through May 5th, 2020 the Town of Tonawanda Youth, Parks & Recreation Department will be accepting registrations for the 2020 Mite Baseball Program. The registration will be at the Youth, Parks & Recreation Department Office, 299 Decatur Road or at the Aquatic and Fitness Center at 1 Pool Plaza.

Mite baseball will give boys and girls the opportunity to participate in a competitive baseball league using coaches or skilled players as pitchers. Games will be four—five innings long played at various Lincoln Park diamonds and will follow normal baseball rules except there will be no standings (win/loss record) kept.

The program is held one night a week, on a rotating basis, either Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday nights (6:00 pm) and Saturday's on a rotating basis (10:00 am or 12:00 pm)

All players will be RATED at the end of registration; more information to come.

The cost of the program will be: \$85.00 (w/o candy), or \$115.00 (with candy)

This fee includes: T-Shirt Jersey, Hat, and Pizza Party in recognition of all participants.
Players can purchase 60 candy bars to sell or eat, if they choose to accept candy.
After candy bar sales, the 9-week program will cost \$55.00 per player

You must register in person at the Recreation Department if you want candy bars to sell.

Registration is limited to the first 180 paid participants or May 5th, so please don't delay!
