Earth Day Clean Up 2019

The Town of Tonawanda Youth, Parks and Recreation Department is hosting the Annual Earth Day Clean Up on Saturday, April 27, focusing on picking up debris along the Rails to Trails Path, & Lincoln Park, This 3.9 mile trail is composed of two segments on top of a former railroad bed in the Town of Tonawanda and the City of Tonawanda.

“We usually get a few hundred people that volunteer as part of this event. It’s a great opportunity for them to help care for our treasured path and parks, and we hope it helps to encourage year-round stewardship,” said Dan Crangle, Town Councilman and Chairman of the Youth, Parks and Recreation Committee.

Volunteers are asked to meet at Lincoln Arena (1200 Parker Blvd, Tonawanda, NY 14223) at 8:00am to receive assignments. You may need to get yourself to a different part of the path, depending on where you are assigned, so please be prepared to provide your own transportation. Dress appropriately for weather, this project will take place rain or shine. Pants, long sleeves, gloves, and boots are encouraged.

This is a great event for families, neighbors, sports teams, youth groups, and coworkers to get involved in their community and become stewards of this new walking and biking path. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

Refreshments and tools will be provided. Parking and restrooms available at Lincoln Arena and Kenny Field.
